Rainwater Harvesting Loans and Grant

- ❑ Shade homes, grow gardens, and support water conservation efforts in Tucson.
- ❑ SERI initiated the program to help limited-income families afford the upfront costs to install rainwater harvesting systems
- ❑ 0-interest loans of up to \$2,000 to pay for these systems over time. Loan has a deposit (the higher amount will be applied) of \$20.00 or 10% of its value.
- ❑ Grants of up to \$750
- ❑ Qualifies for the Tucson Water rebate
- ❑ You will develop a budget and payment plan with SERI staff.
- ❑ 12-18 months to payback your loan
- ❑ You may receive a free tree and shrub based on funding.

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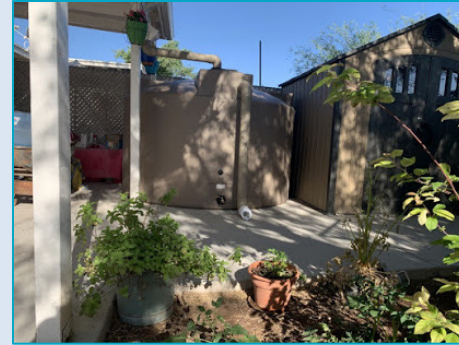

- Attend a workshop

- Income \leq 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Owner-occupied single-family dwelling
- Renters living in single-family dwellings (with signed letter of agreement from landlord)
- Property taxes paid
