Summary:

The Community Green Infrastructure Design Intern will be part of the WMG team working on the Community Block Development Grant (CDBG) program and other projects focused on green infrastructure solutions in limited income neighborhoods. These programs utilize community-driven, participatory design strategies to bring green infrastructure design solutions to vulnerable neighborhoods in order to promote watershed restoration at the local scale while supporting neighborhood beautification and community engagement in target neighborhoods. This intern will assist with technical design, graphic design, community outreach, education, and research tasks to support development of WMG's neighborhood-scale green infrastructure and restoration work.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assist with leading neighborhood engagement and community engagement tasks (70%)
 - Assist with in-person outreach including attending community meetings, events & workshops
 - Assist with designing and distributing outreach materials
 - Work with community neighborhood groups to build community relationships
 - Help identify community assets for outreach and engagement opportunities
- Provide technical design and planning support (15%)
 - Assist with monitoring and maintenance planning and research for existing projects
 - Engage in client meetings, site walk-throughs and other engagement with existing and future sites
- Support long term project work with City and County clients (15%)
 - Assist with developing community resources such as design toolkits and case-study materials for existing projects
 - Assist with research and analysis on priority target areas for green infrastructure

- Ability to travel to restoration sites within 20 miles of WMG office.
