

Summary of the water conservation projects

WCGF has a variety of eligible projects and will cover costs to implement and administer the following:

- Education and research programs on ways to conserve and reduce water consumption, increase water efficiency or increase water reuse.
- Rainwater harvesting, gray water systems, efficiency upgrades, drought resistant landscaping, turf removal, and others (left intentionally broad in scope)
- Programs and projects that reduce structural water overuse problems, groundwater recharge, aquifer health, groundwater conservation and surface water flows.
- Landscape watershed protection, restoration and rehabilitation, (green development, low-impact development)
- Groundwater storage and recovery

Who applies?

- City, towns, county, districts, commission, authorities, public entity under statute, or charter, or initiative
- Nongovernment org focused on water conservation or environmental protection **if it partners with public entity under statute or voter approved charter or initiative.**
- (No individuals or tribes)

Matching funds are required – 25%
